

Hospitals across the state depend on payments funded by provider taxes. Without provider taxes, jurisdictions would face significant funding shortfalls, forcing them to either cut hospital funding—risking closures and reduced services – or raise property taxes, shifting the financial burden onto local residents. This table illustrates the jurisdictions assessing provider taxes within each district and the property tax increase required to replace this revenue. This impact would extend to every county with hospitals relying on provider tax funding from these jurisdictions.
